But in 2018 there were insufficient rides to do this, yet the events were still clustered close together in some periods, with long intervals between rides at other times.

So for the reasons listed below, some riders were unable to take full advantage of the existing rides, having to choose between rides when they were close together, and possibly missing others because they hadn't kept their horse

in work during the lull when there haven't been any rides.

To run the VERA calendar to suit the bigger outfits because they provide sponsorship to some rides, is putting the grass roots members at a disadvantage where they get less benefit from their membership.

RIDER

I believe that one horse/one rider combinations are disadvantaged when rides are scheduled at 2 week intervals.

FINANCIAL Difficultly in paying for 2 rides in the one fortnight if their wage is paid fortnightly.

Riders competing with only one horse won't commit to the next ride until they see how their horse pulls up after the previous ride. But by waiting, they are missing the 2-week pre-nom deadline.

Some riders wish to give their horses more than a 2 week interval between rides.

Some riders are unable to get more than one long weekend a month, when travel needs to be done on a Friday/Monday.

RIDE ORGANISERS are also disadvantaged with a 2 week interval between rides.

IMPACTS ON PLANNING particularly when vets and rugs have to be organised well in advance.
When running a ride 2 weeks after the previous one a lot of our
